Larry's Log,

I'm always exploring new materials, glues and techniques in this hobby. The product pictured, should not be used for structural applications. I used this foam glue to attach the foam tail feathers of a T45 jet. This was a foam to foam application. I spread the glue on

both surfaces. allowed to setup for 10 minutes and then assembled per instructions. After the first flight, one horizontal stab was lose and I pulled it free. The key product description here is "Quick Tack". Lesson learned. I got REAL lucky, I know what would have happened if the stab came off in flight. Instant trash. So. I pealed the foam glue off and replaced it with good old reliable 5 minute epoxy.
