Flying Times and Noise Regulations:

There is **no ordinance** for **electric** powered aircraft. Fly when you want.

Monday through **Friday** there will be no flying **before 7:30 AM**.

Monday through **Friday (Summer)** there will be no flying **after 9:00 P.M.** Summer is defined as May-August.

Monday through **Friday (Winter)** there will be no flying **after sunset**. Winter is defined as September-April.

On **Saturday** and **Sunday** (all year) there will be no flying **before 9:00 A.M.**

On **Saturday** and **Sunday** there will be no flying **after 9:00 P.M.**

Modified exhaust systems i.e. mouse can mufflers, non-muffled tuned pipes, and open exhaust systems will **only be permitted between** the hours of **9:00 A.M.** and **6:00 P.M.**

Monday through **Sunday**. If your plane can pass the AMA's 90 db @ 9 foot rule, you will be allowed to fly within the stock exhaust times.
